Directors Statement

Making this film challenged all of us to consider the things that make us human. Is it our consciousness? Our thoughts and emotions? Or is it our soul?

Juniper explores what those possibilities could mean when someone is tempted to bring back the one person they love the most. One insignificant man in a small town making a god-like decision.

Filming at the directors family farm in East Meredith, NY set the tone of the production. When the idea for the film was first conceived, we knew the farm was the perfect setting for this story.

It was surreal to see the story come to life in such a beautiful place where even the barn is considered an historic structure.

Juniper is a short film produced in NYC, NJ, & Upstate NY. It took several years and countless re-writes until we reached a point where we said to ourselves, "There is so much going on that's trying to stop us. Let's do it now and make it happen no matter what!". And that's exactly what we did...


